

## Midway Park – Fun for All on Chautauqua Lake Since 1898

Originally opened as one of the thousands of “trolley parks” across the country that offered respite and recreation for families in the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries, Midway Park has endured as a destination for family fun and now ranks as the 16<sup>th</sup> oldest continually operating amusement park in the country. At the peak of its popularity in the 1920s, Midway Park hosted events that attracted thousands of visitors who enjoyed swimming and bathing, roller skating, the dance hall, and rides that included the thrilling “Jack Rabbit” roller coaster.

Ownership of Midway Park was held by the JW & NW railroad until 1939, Thomas Carr until 1951, and the Walsh family until the park was purchased by the State of New York in 2007 and continues operations today as Midway State Park. Under the Walsh family and through a growing relationship with the Allan Herschell Co. in nearby North Tonawanda, a complete Herschell kiddyland of rides was installed in the 1950s, soon supplemented by “Dodgem” cars, the “Tilt-A-Whirl”, and the carousel, still the anchors of ride activity at Midway. The games arcade, located in the former trolley depot on the grounds of the park, remains as the other focal point of park activity in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.



The Friends of Midway State Park is a nonprofit organization launched in 2010 whose mission is to work with the State of New York to promote, preserve, maintain, and financially support this historic amusement park that has been enjoyed by children of all ages since 1898. The Friends pursue this mission by:

- Serving as ambassadors and advocates for the park in the wider community by recruiting friends and volunteers, developing corporate and community partners, and networking with the talent and enthusiasm that is needed to keep the park relevant and vital.
- Raising funds to support specific projects through membership, donations, events, grant writing, and other fund development efforts.
- Striving through volunteer service to preserve, maintain, and interpret the park’s historic character and beauty.

Among the priorities to be pursued by the membership in the near future are assisting the state and park management to restore treasured traditions like park fireworks and preserve the:

- Herschell Carousel and its roundhouse shelter.
- Roller Skating “hippodrome” and dance hall.
- Picnic pavilions, group meeting facilities, shoreline, and walking trails.


